



# Traffic Controller (Stop / Slow Bat) Blue Card

The NSW Roads & Traffic Authority (RTA) requires that to work as a Traffic Controller, you must hold a current Traffic Controllers Photo Card which you attain on successful completion of this course\*.

## Who should enrol in this course?

This course is designed for people wanting to control traffic around roads/ construction sites (STOP / SLOW bat).

## Course Duration:

- 7 Hours = 5 hours theory + 2 hours practical (not including breaks)

## Pre-Requisites:

Participants must meet the following requirements before their intended course date in order to be eligible to commence the Training Course:

- Adequate literacy
- Hold a valid NSW WorkCover OHS Construction Induction Certificate\*\* (Green Card) or equivalent
- A NSW P2 Drivers Licence or equivalent or higher OR a NSW Traffic Controller Photo Card (which has expired within the last two years)

*\*\*Note that participants who do not hold the NSW WorkCover Construction Induction Certificate at the commencement of training will only be eligible to receive a Traffic Controller- Non Construction Grey Photo Card*

## Course Content:

On completion of the training, participants will be able to:

- Understand the role of a Traffic Controller
- Apply the procedures of traffic controlling within a worksite
- Operate a 2-way radio correctly
- Promote the role of a traffic controller in the community

- NSW WorkCover OHS Construction Induction Certificate (Green/White Card)
- A NSW P2 Drivers Licence or equivalent or higher OR a NSW Traffic Controller Photo Card (which has expired within the last two years)
